Trial Details

Please note the following rules & procedures for CASSA Trials (that may be a little different to what you normally expect if you are already trialling).

*The "<u>competitor briefing</u>" will be within this catalogue. This will include class details and include Search Areas and any additional details you need to know on the evening.

*Registration Desk will be at the main entry to the Cyril Road Hall – please arrive before the trial starts and make yourself known so you can be marked present.

* No competitor numbers will be required – we simply work with your name HOWEVER please assist us in keeping the night running smoothly and be ready for your turn. Keep an eye on the dogs a few spots ahead of you – if you aren't sure who they are – ask around – people will be very happy to help.

*Refreshment Station – please note, this is dog free zone set up near the entry to the Hall. There will be complimentary iced drinks and refreshments.

*Two warm up pipes will be available for use – one with odour and one without.

*Each search consists of two minutes. Once any part of you or your dog cross the start cones the timer will start the countdown. There will be no 30 second warning.

*Once your dog has found the hide the competitor only needs to communicate to the Judge by saying the words "alert" no finish call is required.

*At the conclusion of each search, the Judge will award you Q or NQ ribbon – there will be no formal presentations following the trial so you may wish to head off home or stay and celebrate/support your friends! Your Q will be recorded in the CASSA database – no further information is required from you for us to monitor your title progress.

*Spectators are WELCOME ③ (including family & friends) – please ensure they are familiar with the rules. Competitors may watch other searches <u>after</u> they have competed.

Please note: spectators will not be allowed to enter or leave whilst a dog is searching, however under direction of the Steward or Judge you may come and go. No food or drink allowed. They must remain behind the spectator viewing area and silent during searches.

*All searches will be videoed and posted in the CASSA Members Private Facebook page following the trial (open to CASSA Members & Organisers only). Should you not wish to have your search videoed please advise the judge prior to your search.

Independence Class

The Search Area, max 6m x 6m, will consist of a search area with start line at one end and one hide at the other end, a minimum of 4m from the start line.

As the team approaches the start line, and the handler will remove the lead and set the dog up for search. The dog must enter between the start cones and leave the handler to search. At no time may any part of the handlers body pass over the start line and handler must remain between the start cones.

The search will conclude, once the dog has communicated to the handler where the hide is located, and the Alert is confirmed by the judge (if incorrect a Q will apply) the maximum time runs out or the team NQ.

Please remember, this is an <u>OFF LEAD ONLY</u> class and dogs are to be under control of the handler at all times. The handler may only walk into the search to retrieve & reward their dog once Alert has been called and judge acknowledged. The judge reserves the right to stop the search if concerned about the safety of the judge or stewards. Time limit 2 minutes.

Clusters Class

The Search Area will be 6m x 6m and consist of four search areas marked out with tape on the ground, with the start line at one quadrant. Each square will contain 5 containers to be searched and cleared systematically until the hide is found. The search will conclude once the dog has communicated to the handler where the hide is located, and the Alert is confirmed by the judge (if incorrect a NQ will apply), the maximum time runs out or the team NQ.



The team may move around the square in any direction, however once the dog moves into the next quadrant (any part of their paw entering the next area counts) the previously worked squared is considered CLEARED and you may not go back to it ③

PARKING, PEEING & PAPERWORK

COMPETITORS – Purple rectangles indicate areas for parking (there is overflow parking in the church across the road on Western Ave, should it be required). The Pink square is the Hall and the vicinity of the searches. The registration desk and Refreshment Station will be held just outside of the entrance door.

The car park can be very busy and stressful environment to some dogs (and people!) – should you have a dog that requires a little more space to feel comfortable – we would recommend you park in the Western Ave car bays. This is still close, yet away from the packed car park and will allow your dog to be a little less stressed or cause stress to those around you. Please be mindful – we are in suburbia and the occasional bark is ok, however dogs that bark non-stop or showing signs of stress may be asked to leave.

TOILETS – please ask at the registration desk for directions – the main hall toilets may be used before the searches (unless hides are being set – the door will be shut). During searches – the Male Toilets in the second hall may be accessed from the outside (the search exit area – look for the light) will become Unisex and used.
