

Summer School for DWD Competitors

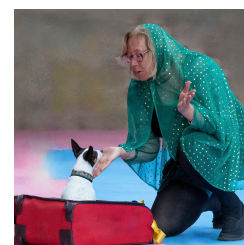


Lift your game in the DWD ring,
during this four week intensive course.

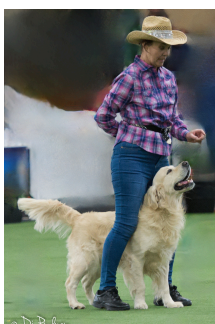
Already competing in Freestyle or Heelwork To Music?

Classes will be held in the grounds of Dogs SA, Cromwell Rd Kilburn.

Sessions will run each Tuesday evening in January, 8:30pm - 9:30pm.

8:15 - 8:30 will be time to exercise your dog, then sign-in and get yourself and your dog settled and ready to train.

This will be followed promptly at 8:30pm by an intensive hour of small group teaching and practice.



Registration is open to healthy, vaccinated, friendly dogs over twelve months old, that have already performed in at least one DWD competition.
